Digital Filmmaking (Basic)

Digital Filmmaking 1 is designed to introduce students to the fundamentals of filmmaking. After learning the general production principals, techniques and operation of video tools such as cameras, microphones and editing programs, the students will work as a team to create a five minute short film. The skills taught in this program are essential for anyone interested in pursuing a career in TV or film production. This course will also give you a head start if you plan on applying to film school or majoring in a TV or film related degree.

Digital Filmmaking (Advanced)

Digital Filmmaking 2 is a follow-up to its precursor, Digital Filmmaking 1. After already learning the fundamentals of filming and editing, the students will focus on more advanced topics, such as lighting, shot composition, detailed audio and video editing, and after effects. The group will divide into two production teams and share the duties as producer, videographer and editor in the process of creating a ten minute short film. The skills taught in this program are essential for anyone interested in pursuing a career in TV or film production. This course will also give you a head start if you plan on applying to film school or majoring in a TV or film related degree.

Photoshop

In this course students will learn the basics of Adobe Photoshop— a sought after skill for many jobs in the creative fields. Instructor Jane Taylor will introduce basic tools in the program, as well as work on project completion and advanced applications. All materials provided. If students have a digital camera, they are welcome to bring it, otherwise, students will capture images using a provided camera during class time. This is the perfect next step in the Teen Digital Arts program— students who have already taken the Digital Filmmaking class are encouraged to register.
