WELCOME TO ARTLETICS 2026!

We are thrilled to welcome both new and returning campers! This summer is going to be fun, purposeful, and one to remember for our campers. Over the summer, campers will make many memories and friendships!

Each day, campers will rotate through multiple activities. These activities will give your camper(s) the opportunity to create beautiful art projects, participate in drama performances, expand their athletic ability, and develop logical and reasoning skills through games. We offer both a gardening club and a science club to encourage campers to explore more of nature and the world around them. Fridays are unique days in the weekly schedule which feature unique activities, visits by guest artists, and of course an end of the week water day.

In addition to the fantastic activities, every week will feature an “Artist(s) of the Week”. Campers will learn about different musicians, dancers, actors, and careers in the Arts realm. Throughout camp, we will weave in social-emotional literacy skills (handle emotions in a positive way, work productively in a group, persistence, building confidence and competence) throughout all aspects of the camp activities.

As you can see, we have a lot of wonderful things in store for your campers and we can't wait to begin! Please see below for important information.

- Camp is held for 8 weeks, Monday – Friday, beginning on June 29th and ending on August 2nd.
- **Camp begins at 9:00 am**
 - Rise-n-shine option available from 7:00 am to 8:30 am
 - Campers can be dropped off anytime between 8:30 am and 9:00 am
- **Camp ends at 3:00 pm**
 - After camp option available from 3:30 pm to 5 pm
 - Campers may be picked up anytime between 3:00 pm and 3:30 pm
- Sunscreen and sneakers should be worn daily.
- Please send your child with a water bottle with their name on it each day.
- Make sure your camper brings a swimsuit and towel for any water days! An announcement and a notice will be sent home in advance.
- Every Thursday, campers will give a drama performance at 2:30. Be on the lookout for more details. Campers are encouraged to wear their camp t-shirts on Thursdays.
- Lunch will be available for campers through the Rome City School District. However, campers are welcome to bring their lunch if they choose to.
- Campers don't need to bring anything from home (i.e. NO toys, electronics, etc.) We are not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- If brought, every morning, campers' phones, iPods, etc., will be collected and will be put in a basket in the office. If there is any emergency and you must reach your child, please call the RACC at (315) 336-1040.
